The pouches can easily accommodate large, low profile wheels and tires, and can even be private labeled by car clubs, manufacturers and associations alike.

The Emergency Tire Tote is designed to take the mess out of changing a tire. The limited use kit features an "all-in-one" travel pouch that includes a pair of gloves, a tire pouch, basic tire-changing instructions and a towelette. The pouch itself converts to a knee pad to protect your clothing while changing the tire. By fitting the disposable tire tote over the damaged tire, you protect both you and your vehicle from dirt and grime while changing and transporting the damaged tire.

4TEK, LLC: KreepKart

It's not often that people refer to automotive creepers and seated carts as "cool," but 4tek LLC has invented what may just be the coolest creeper and cart, ever. 4tek debuted its Kreepster at last year's SEMA, and was awarded with "The people's choice new product award" at this year's SEMA show.

But we were immediately captivated by the KreepKart, which should be available sometime in the early part of 2004 with a rough suggested price of around \$250. Much like the readily available Kreepster, the KreepKart is a complete redesign of the conventional seated garage cart, featuring a full-formed, 6061 T6 tube aluminum frame, high quality shock absorbers and ultra-smooth, roller ball bearing wheels. The KreepKart features plenty of easy-to-access pockets and holders, ensuring ample "on cart" storage of items such as towels, detailing sprays and products, tools, drinks and so on.
